Life can have its uncertainty but faith will always bring us hope and see us through. Manistee Catholic Central School has been the foundation for spiritual, intellectual and physical growth, but most importantly... a relationship with our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

Over the past few months, our Manistee Catholic Central School community was hit with devastating news regarding the financial status of our school. It has brought about many questions and an outpour of emotions. It began with the discovery of uncollected past due tuition stemming back a number of years. The school has also endured frequent changes to the administration resulting in a lack of oversight that allowed expenses to significantly outpace revenue. Unfortunately, this information was not made known, nor was it ever presented, to the Foundation.

Father Mitchel Roman and Father Michael Linguar, both priests at Divine Mercy Parish as of June 2023, have reached out to the Catholic community with transparency and an appeal to come together to reach a resolve. The unpaid tuition is substantial. Every effort is being made to collect on tuition owed, but it is unlikely any significant amount will be collected. Even if all of the tuition were to be collected, it will not be enough to save or sustain the school as it operates today. *Immediate funding is needed as we are preparing for the 2024-2025 school year.*

There are efforts being made to develop new programs to attract more students, find new revenue streams, and reduce costs to make MCC financially viable for the future. In addition, a significant investment in an endowment must be made to supplement tuition revenue and steps are needed to create more thorough oversight. Manistee is not a wealthy area and cannot support a substantial increase in tuition rates. As for the building, God is already clearing the path to handle these infrastructure concerns. A Christ-centered education shouldn't just be for inner cities or wealthy areas. Christ came for all of us. He makes all things new, and we are confident MCC will evolve into something even greater if given a chance.



It is with a heavy heart that we appeal to you as Alumni, supporters and family. This is a very critical time for our school. A time we had hoped would never come. We have weathered many challenges over the years, but it has always been our faith and school family that has brought us through. May this be the same, once again.
